- They violated the law by not taking her to the judge.
- They violated Roman law by suggesting that she be stoned.

LOGICAL

- They interrupted Jesus as he was teaching.
- Their hypocrisy was obvious.
- Their attempt to match wits with the Almighty was laughable.

Condemnation Or *Forgiveness*

LOVING

- The Jewish leaders came for condemnation and they walked away with their own.
- Jesus purpose:
 - John 3:16-17
 - John 12:47
- This doesn't teach tolerance but compassion and forgiveness.
