 - •The battle is fought/Absalom is killed.
 - David regains his throne.
 - •The King is returning home!
 - Let's explore the condition of 4 men upon the King's return.



THE RETURN OF THE KING

Shimei was **WORRIED**

- II Sam. 19:16-20
- •II Sam. 16:5-8
 - A descendant of Saul.
 - •Angry about the change in regency.
 - •Threw stones, flung dust, cursed David.



THE RETURN OF THE IKING

Mephibosheth was **WAITING**

- •II Sam. 19:24
- •He was distraught at the departure of the King.
- Mourning the situation in which he found himself and his nation.
 - •Titus 2:13; Heb. 9:28; II Peter 3:12



THE RETURN OF THE KING

Barzillai was WORKING

- II Sam. 17:27-29
- •II Sam. 19:31-32
- •He was doing whatever he could for his king.
 - •I Cor. 15:58
 - •Heb. 6:10
 - II Thess. 2:13-17



THE RETURN OF THE MING

Sheba was WITHOUT

- •II Sam. 20:1-2
- •He was called a worthless man.
- •He chose to have no relationship with the King.
 - •Matt. 25:41
 - •Matt. 7:21-23
