- No one is Good except God alone

Keep my Commandments

- Jesus tells him to keep my commandments
 - Do not murder
 - Do not commit adultery
 - Do not steel
 - Do not bear false witness
 - Do not defraud
 - Honor your father and mother

Exodus 20

- 1. No other gods before me
- 2. You shall not make yourself a carved image
- 3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain
- 4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it Holy
- 5. Honor your father and mother

Exodus 20

- 6. You shall not murder
- 7. You shall not commit adultery
- 8. You shall not steal
- 9. You shall not bear false witness
- 10. You shall not covet

Rich young man's response

- "All of these I have kept from my youth"
- He lacked one thing v.21
- The rich young man served money and not God v.22
- Jesus knew that

Jesus talks to his disciples

- "How difficult it will be for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God"
- "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye
 of a needle then for a rich person to enter the
 kingdom of God." v.25

Eye of a needle

- Needle gate that is found in Jerusalem where a camel would go through at night to enter the city.
- A greek scribe messed up on a translation with the greek camel (Kamila) and greek large rope (Kamela)
- Jesus was talking about a literal camel and needle.
- Without God's grace, all things are impossible.
