

# Listening or Hearing?

- Hearing: The faculty of receiving sounds.
- akróasi: hearing, faculty of hearing

- Listening: give one's attention to sound.
- aboûte: I hear, Listen, Comprehend

- Hearing is simply the act of perceiving sound by the ear. If you are not hearingimpaired, hearing simply happens.
- Listening, however, is something you consciously choose to do. Listening leads to learning.

# Listening leads to learning

- \* "You heard me but you weren't listening"
- ◆ Hearing a teacher and listening to a teacher could be the difference between passing and failing.
- Hearing a boss and listening to a boss could be the difference from having a job and not having one.

### The Fall of Man

- Genesis 3:1-3
- v.3 "You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the midst of the garden, neither shall you touch it, lest you die."
- Eve heard what God Said, she just didn't listen to him.

## Jonah Doesn't hear God

- Jonah 1:4; 17; 3:1-3
- Jonah listened to God but he didn't hear him
- Jonah 1:17 And the Lord appointed a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

# Conversion of Saul

- Acts 9:1-9
- Saul listened to what Jesus said and followed his directions
- v. 15 "... He is a chosen instrument of mine..."
- Paul went on to proclaim God's word and author many of the new testament texts.

#### Noah and the Flood

- Genesis 6: 11-14
- Noah listened to God when he told him to build an ark.
- Since Noah listened to God, He and his family were saved from the flood.

#### Peters Sermon at Pentecost

- Acts 2:14; 40-47
- v.14 "and give ear to my words"
- v.41 "So those who received his word were baptized"
- They didn't just hear what Peter said, they listened.
