- Two circumstances/ two approaches to correction.
 - Younger son
 - The father had to let the son go.
 - The son had to hit rock bottom.
 - The son had to admit that he had a problem.
 - The son had to make the decision to seek help himself and seek help from the right source.
 - The father forgave the son and rejoiced in his recovery.

- Two circumstances/ two approaches to correction.
 - Older son
 - The father went out after him.
 - The father reasoned with him.
 - This approach was different because this son had always been obedient but needed his father's guidance.
 - The likelihood is that he responded favorably. The father does not revoke his status but reassures it.
