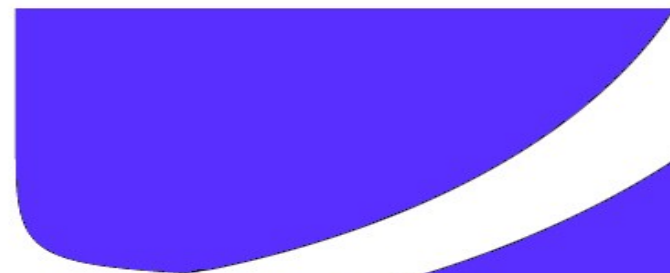

# Genesis 4:25-26

# Genesis 6:7-9

- So the Lord said, “I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, **one righteous man** and a creature that I have made, the birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them.”
- But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord...Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.”

# Genesis 12:1-3

- *“Now the Lord had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, From your family And from your father’s house To a land that I will show you.”*  
**one obedient man**  
*And I will make you a great nation; And I will bless you, And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing.*
- *I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”*

# Genesis 37:21

- *“But Reuben heard it, and he delivered him out of their hands, and said, “Let us not kill*  
**one voice of reason***”*
- *And Reuben said to them, “Shed no blood, but cast him into this pit which is in the wilderness, and do not lay a hand on him”—that he might deliver him out of their hands, and bring him back to his father.”*

# Genesis 50:20

- *“But as for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive.”*

# Exodus 1:8-11

- *“Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph.”*  
**one forgetful king**  
*“And he said to his people, ‘Look, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we...’”*
- *“Therefore they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with their burdens.”*

# Exodus 2:2-3

- *“So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him for herself in the house of her father-in-law, Amram. But when she could no longer hide him, she took an ark of bulrushes for him, daubed it with asphalt and pitch, put the child in it, and laid it in the reeds by the river’s bank.”*

# Exodus 32:9-11

- And the Lord said to Moses, “I see that you are the son of a stiff-necked people; they are stiff-necked people. Now therefore, let me alone, that my wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation.”

# *Exodus 32:9-11*

- *Then Moses pleaded with the Lord his God, and said: “Lord, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people ... Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people.*



# Numbers 27:13-14

- “And when you have seen it, you also shall be a witness to your people. And you shall say to them, ‘Gather the people together!’”
- “For in the Wilderness of Zin, during the strife of the congregation, you were disobedient to the command to hallow me at the waters before their eyes.” (These are the waters of Meribah, at Kadesh in the Wilderness of Zin.)

# *1 Samuel 17:32*

- *“Then David said to Saul,  
**one young man**  
because of him; your servant  
will go and fight with this  
Philistine.”*

# *Luke 1:30-31*

- *Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.
