# *At Home with* **PRISCILLA and AQUILA**

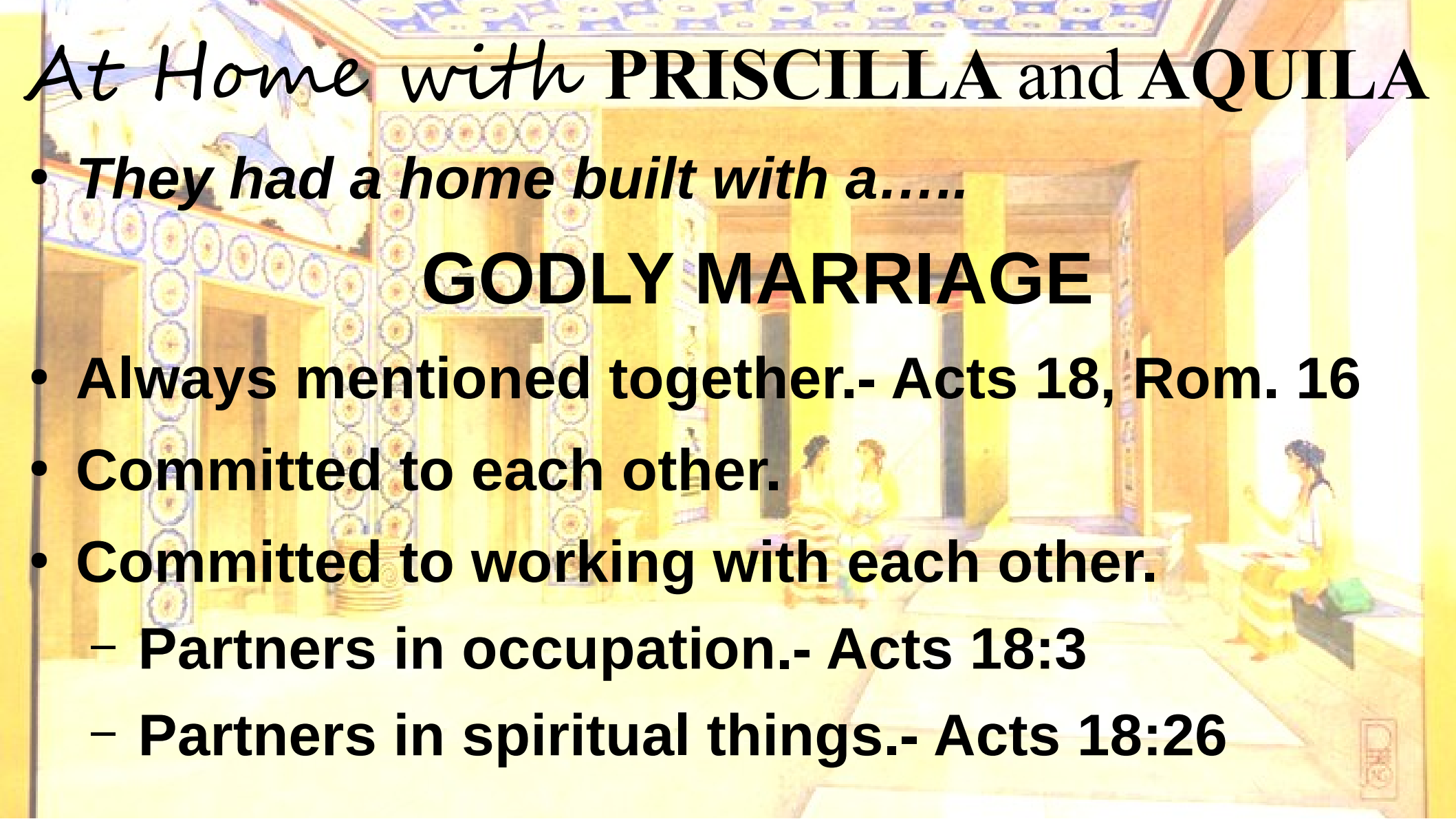
- **Their home was and continues to be a model for Christian couples.**

  - **Ephesus- I Cor. 16- Paul wrote from Ephesus**
