- The Jews in Jerusalem didn't question his status as a Christian.

- II Corinthians 7:5-9
- He seems to have delivered a “severe letter” to the church from Paul.
- The end result was the repentance of the Corinthians and the rejoicing of Paul.

MANAGERIAL MASTER

- II Corinthians 8:6-7- Titus was charged with starting and completing the benevolent collection.
- Titus 1:5- He was left alone on the island of Crete and tasked by Paul to set in order the things that the Christians needed to hear and to appoint elders in every city.

- A Tenderhearted minister- II Cor. 7:15; 8:16
- A Teaching minister- Titus 1:5
- A Traveling minister- II Tim. 4:10
 - Was connected to congregations in Syria, Galatia, Achaia, Asia, Crete, Macedonia, Jerusalem and Dalmatia.
