Intro:

- A. Text: Romans 10:12-17
- B. Verse 13 says, "For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- C. The previous text indicates how important it is to call on the name of the Lord.
- D. Let's examine the context of this chapter and then unravel what it means to call on the name of the Lord.
- E. Paul is discussing the problem with which Israel (the Jews) are struggling. They have not embraced the system of faith in Christ versus adherence to the Law of Moses.
- F. Paul states that it does not take superhuman works to have Christ (vs. 6-7), he has already been given to you. A person need only to put their faith and trust in him.
- G. This is another way of saying "call on the name of the Lord."
- H. *Calling on the name of the Lord means.....*
