CALLING ON THE NAME OF THE LORD

- Romans 10:13 says, “For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”
- That makes calling on the name of the Lord pretty significant.
- Let’s examine the context of chapter 10 and unravel the meaning of this directive.

CALLING ON THE NAME OF THE LORD

- Paul is addressing the problem with which Israel (the Jews) are struggling.
- They had not embraced the system of faith and instead were seeking righteousness through adherence to the Law of Moses.
- Paul says that a person need only put their faith and trust in Jesus.

CALLING ON THE NAME OF THE LORD

- *Calling on the name of the Lord means.....*

APPEALING TO THE AUTHORITY OF CHRIST

- Romans 10:1-4
- The previous authority had been eliminated by Christ.
- Paul understood this. He had been guilty of it also.-
Consider Acts 22:16
