- Romans 10:13 says, "For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- That makes calling on the name of the Lord pretty significant.
- Let's examine the context of chapter 10 and unravel the meaning of this directive.

- Paul is addressing the problem with which Israel (the Jews) are struggling.
- They had not embraced the system of faith and instead were seeking righteousness through adherence to the Law of Moses.
- Paul says that a person need only put their faith and trust in Jesus.

- Paul understood this. He had been guilty of it also.-Consider Acts 22:16
