

- The second half of "Tell it like it is Tuesday" involves Jesus's interaction with his disciples.
  - It begins with Jesus's conversation with the disciples as they are leaving the Temple.
  - It continues, when the disciples approach him on the Mount of Olives with questions.
  - It ends with Jesus's "be vigilant" parables and description of his Second Coming.

- Jesus tells about the Destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple.
  - The disciples are gushing about the Temple (Mark 13:1).
  - Jesus informs them that at some point all of those buildings will be destroyed and not one stone will be left upon another.
  - That must have been shocking and scary.

- The disciples now have questions that they would like answered.
  - Three questions are asked:
    - When will these things be?
    - What will be the sign of his coming?
    - What will be the sign of the end of the age?

- When will these things be?
  - Concerning the Destruction of Jerusalem, before this generation passes away. (Matt. 24:34)
  - Concerning his 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, no one knows except the Father. (Matt. 24:36)
  - In this chapter, Jesus is speaking of two different events but they share some similarities.

- Jesus talks about being prepared for his 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming.
  - Three sections:
    - Have Gospel- The 10 Virgins
    - Have Gumption- The Talents
      - -"The ability to make intelligent decisions, initiative." (Merriam-Webster)
    - · Have Grace- (charis)-Listen to Strong's def.
