- Servant of the king, who couldn't stand the thought of Jeremiah the prophet suffering.
- Went to the king personally to beg for the prophets release.
- Then went to get old garments to help lift him up.

Our story describes.....

A MAN OF FAITH

- Jeremiah
- Kept preaching an unpopular message.
- Mistreated by the people and the king.
- What a man of courage knowing the fate the people intended for him down in that cistern.

- What about the fate of these men?
 - Zedekiah witnessed the annihilation of his family and his nation. He died a coward and lost.
 - Ebedmelech's life was spared because of his kindness and trust in God.
 - Jeremiah was delivered and instructions were given by Nebuchad. to look after him well.
