### There must be a motivation by the Holy Spirit.



"Above reproach" (1 Tim. 3:2, Titus 1:6)
"Respectable" (1 Tim. 3:2) "Well thought of by outsiders" (1 Tim. 3:7)





### Character of a Shepherd:

### Family Management

"He must manage his own household well, with all dignity keeping his children submissive" (1 Tim. 3:4) "His children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination" (Titus 1:6).

### Character of a Shepherd:


#### Personal Self-Control

### Character of a Shepherd: Relationship Skills

Gentle, Upright, Not Quarrelsome, Not Arrogant, Not Quick Tempered, Humble.





#### Top 5 relationship skills people want in a leader:
