# Christ-like



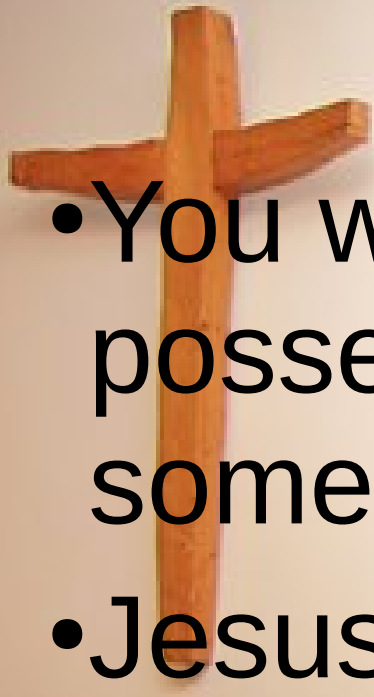
- Why?

# Charity and Love


- Christ loved all people

# Knowledge




- You won't always have your tangible possessions, but your knowledge is something you'll have for eternity

- How do we develop our knowledge?


# Patience

-

  - No one displayed patience better than Christ
  - John 8:1-11
  - How can we develop patience like Christ?


# Humility

-

- If anyone didn't have to be humble, it was Jesus.
  - To some, humility is a sign of weakness. In reality it is a sign of spiritual power
  - Jesus shows his humility in John 13:1-17
  - How can we work on developing humility?

  - Jesus obeyed his parents (Luke 2:49-52)
  - Jesus obeyed God (Matthew 26:39)

# Christ-like Attributes
