Scary Stories with a Haunting Message

- The haunting message from First Samuel 3:1-14

"The Lord said to Samuel, "Behold, I am about to do a thing in Israel at which the two ears of everyone who hears it will tingle. Therefore, I swear to the house of Eli that the iniquity of Eli's house shall not be atoned for by sacrifice or offering forever." (11, 14)

Scary Stories with a Haunting Message

• *The haunting message from First Samuel 28:3-19*

“.....the Lord has turned from you and become your enemy.... Moreover, the Lord will give Israel also with you into the hand of the Philistines, and tomorrow you and your sons shall be with me.”

(verses 16, 19)

Scary Stories with a Haunting Message

- *The haunting message from Daniel 5*

"....MENE, God has numbered the days of your kingdom and brought it to an end; TEKEL, you have been weighed in the balances and found wanting; PERES, your kingdom has been divided and given to the Medes and Persians." (26-28)

Scary Stories with a Haunting Message

- The haunting message from Matthew 27:50-54

"Truly this was the Son of God."

(vs. 54)
