- A. The word "vein" can be defined as groundlessly, pointlessly, deceitfully.

- B. Jesus described this type of worship in Matthew 15:8-9
 - 1. People honored God with their lips
 - 2. Their hearts were far from Him
- 3. Teaching as their doctrines the precepts of men

Ignorant Worship

- A. Ignorant worship is found in Acts 17:23; an alter with the inscription "TO AN UNKNOWN GOD" B. Paul did admit that these people were "very religious" (Acts 17:22) C. Paul also said, "What therefore you
- C. Paul also said, "What therefore you worship in ignorance, this I set forth to you" (Acts 17:23)

Will-Worship

A. Will-Worship (Col. 2.23) is only mentioned one time in the new testament B. Will-Worship is the kind of worship devised by man C. Matthew 6:1-8 E. Nadab and Abihu (Lev. 10:1-2) were guilty of Will-Worship

True Worship

A. God seeks true worshipers who worship in spirit and in truth (John 4:23) B. They that worship God MUST worship in spirit and in truth (John 4:24) C. If we go beyond what God has authorized, there will be consequences (2 John 9; Rev. 22:18-19)

- D. True worship is very different from other types of worship
- 1. True worship is wholly governed by God, whereas all other forms of worship are governed by men
- 2. True worship is focused on God and spiritual things, not earthly matters
