- Paul says about the conduct of Peter, Barnabas and other Jews, that their behavior was....
 - Condemning- 2:11
 - Cowardly- 2:12
 - Hypocritical- 2:13
 - Misleading- 2:13
 - Contrary to the truth- 2:14

- Romans 3:23
- Peter was a human and we are very familiar with several occasions where he disappointed Jesus.

 - REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE HUMAN
- Romans 7:14-25- (Paul made mistakes)
- I John 1:8
 - How many times have we been guilty of disappointing someone?

- When influential men disappoint you......
 - BRING IT TO THEIR ATTENTION
- Paul let Peter and others know about this wrong that they had committed.
 - Galatians 6:1
 - **James 5:15**

• When influential men disappoint you......

LET THEM MAKE IT RIGHT

- Acts 15- Peter seems to redeem himself with the Council in Jerusalem.
 - Certainly, Paul had a hand in relating this information to his travel companion.
