Overcoming Temptations

- Notable passages of Scripture on temptations:
 - Luke 17:1
 - James 1:13-21
 - I Corinthians 10:13
- Jesus teaches us how to overcome temptations in Luke 4.

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- Additional details from Luke:
 - Jesus was “full of the Spirit” 4:1.
 - 3 temptations we remember happened at the conclusion of the 40 days- 4:2-3.
 - Gross arrogance of the devil is highlighted- 4:6.
 - The devil departed after he had ended every temptation- 4:13.
 - Jesus returned in the “power of the Spirit.”- 4:14.

Overcoming Temptations

- In order to overcome temptations, all temptations then we need to be “full of the Spirit”
 - Let the word of Christ dwell in you.
 - Eph. 5:19, Col. 3:16
 - Attend worship- Heb. 10:25
 - Practice the fruit of the Spirit- Gal. 5
