- Text: James 4:7- "Submit yourselves therefore to God."
- The word submission is a word that conjures in the minds of many negative thoughts.
 - Weakness
 - Inferiority
 - Oppression
 - Misogynous
- This behavior has been almost forgotten in some circles.

- And yet, God insists that his people practice submisison.
- A study of the word submission reveals the following:
 - Two Greek words are represented by our English word.
 - Hupotasso (submit)
 - Hupeiko (submit)- Hebrews 13:17 (Compound word "hupo" (under) and "eiko" (to yield, be weak). In other words "to surrender."

- Two English words are represented by one of the Greek words.
- In almost all cases in the New Testament the words <u>subject</u> and <u>submit</u> (and their variations) are designated by the same Greek word.
- <u>Hupotasso</u>- A compound word from "hupo" which means under or below and "tasso" which means to arrange in an orderly manner. Thus it means "to obey, subdue, put under, submit, subject."

- But really, we just don't like this idea.
- We can go all the way back to Genesis 3:16 to see evidence of the concept. (Please remember that this is God talking not your preacher.)
- Is it my imagination, or did God just tell the woman that her husband was supposed to "rule over her?"

- That is strong language. We sure don't like that in our current society.
- Try putting that in modern wedding vows.
- But, the idea of submission goes way beyond the husband and wife relationship.
- Our study today will consider areas in which all of us need to be submissive.
