# ONDEMNATION II Peter 1:2

- The opening statement of Second Peter is addressed "to those who have obtained a faith of equal standing with ours."
- What a wonderful thought for the readers. To think that they enjoyed an equal status spiritually with someone of the apostle Peter's caliber.
- But really, it is more about the righteousness of Jesus than it is the caliber of Peter.

- What about those who find themselves on the other end of the spectrum?
- Those who have not obtained an equal standing of faith with Peter or his intended audience.
- Today, I want us to think about those who have obtained an equal standing of condemnation.

- There are multiple purposes for doing a lesson like this.
  - First, the hope is that someone who is outside of Christ will make a decision today to change their standing.
  - Second, to move our hearts as Christians to an awareness of the many lost people who share a lot in common with us.

- Equal standing of condemnation applies to....
- We know of others that are living today who are great people; benevolent, kind, caring, even spiritual but not on equal standing with us in faith because they have never been baptized into Christ.
- The good news is Romans 8:1, "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."
