- If this indeed is the approach of the Master then why is it not the approach of his church?
- It seems that we have gotten his approach backwards.
 - We have become weak on sin and hard on sinners.

- We have become conformers and not transformers. (Romans 12:1-2)
- If we are ever going to effectively reach people for Christ and grow his church then we must abhor sin but love humanity.

- Soft on sinners when it comes to our involvement with them. (admonish them as a brother)- II Thess. 3:15
- Soft on sinners when it comes to the impact of their sin (apathetic to their condition)- Rom. 9:2; 10:1-3
