What is the Gospel?

- Besorah- Good news- occurs 7 times in the Old Testament
- Euongelion- good news- occurs over 70 times in the New Testament
- The Gospels are not biographies in the modern sense of the word.
- Tonight we will be looking at what the gospel "good news" does for us

Fills Our Hearts- 1 Corinthians 15:1-4

- Faithful father, loving family, unconditional love, a guide for life, a life-changing promise
- Throughout the gospels we read of truths, promises, and more
- Each person is different, the gospel helps replace the bad in life with the good
- But perhaps the most powerful aspect all is the hope we have for eternity in Heaven with God

Great Expectation-Isaiah 9:1-7

- As humans we often get impatient when we are waiting on something
- When John starts announcing the gospel in the first century (Mark 1:1-8), the nation of Israel had been waiting a long time.
- Isaiah comes out and says (Isaiah 9:6)
- What are we looking for in life?

Modern Day Gospel Stories- Mark 1:1;14-15

- We all have people in our lives that we have seen change their lives for God
- The issue is, if we want to hear more stories about people changing their lives, we must be the ones to tell them about the gospel.
- Look at the people around you and see who needs
- to hear the good news of the gospel

The Bad News- 2 Thessalonians 1:5-12

- By definition, if there is good news, there must be bad news.
- In modern society the idea of being saved is difficult to accept
- We must be the ones to tell the bad news
 - Matthew 7:13-14;21-23
- We must prepare ourselves to lovingly share the bad news with those who must hear it in order to accept the good news

What Are You Going To Do About It? Romans 12:2

- The Bible is the only guide to inheriting the Kingdom of Heaven
