- •II Sam. 13:1-6
 - He had a <u>heart</u> that <u>devised</u> evil plans- Prov. 6:18.
 - He was fine with sowing <u>discord</u> among <u>brethren</u>- Prov. 6:19.

Consider......

Jonadab, son of Shimeah, David's brother

- •II Sam. 13:30-33,35
 - He was in on <u>everybody's</u> business. Decided against warning "<u>his friend</u>" (II Sam. 13:3).
 - Told people what they wanted to hear.
 - Didn't take <u>credit</u> for helping cause the <u>tragedy</u>.

Consider......

Jonathon, son of Shimeah, David's brother

- •II Sam. 21:18-21
 - He was a warrior for King David.
 - I Tim. 6:11-16
 - He was a defender of his nation.
 - I Peter 2:9
