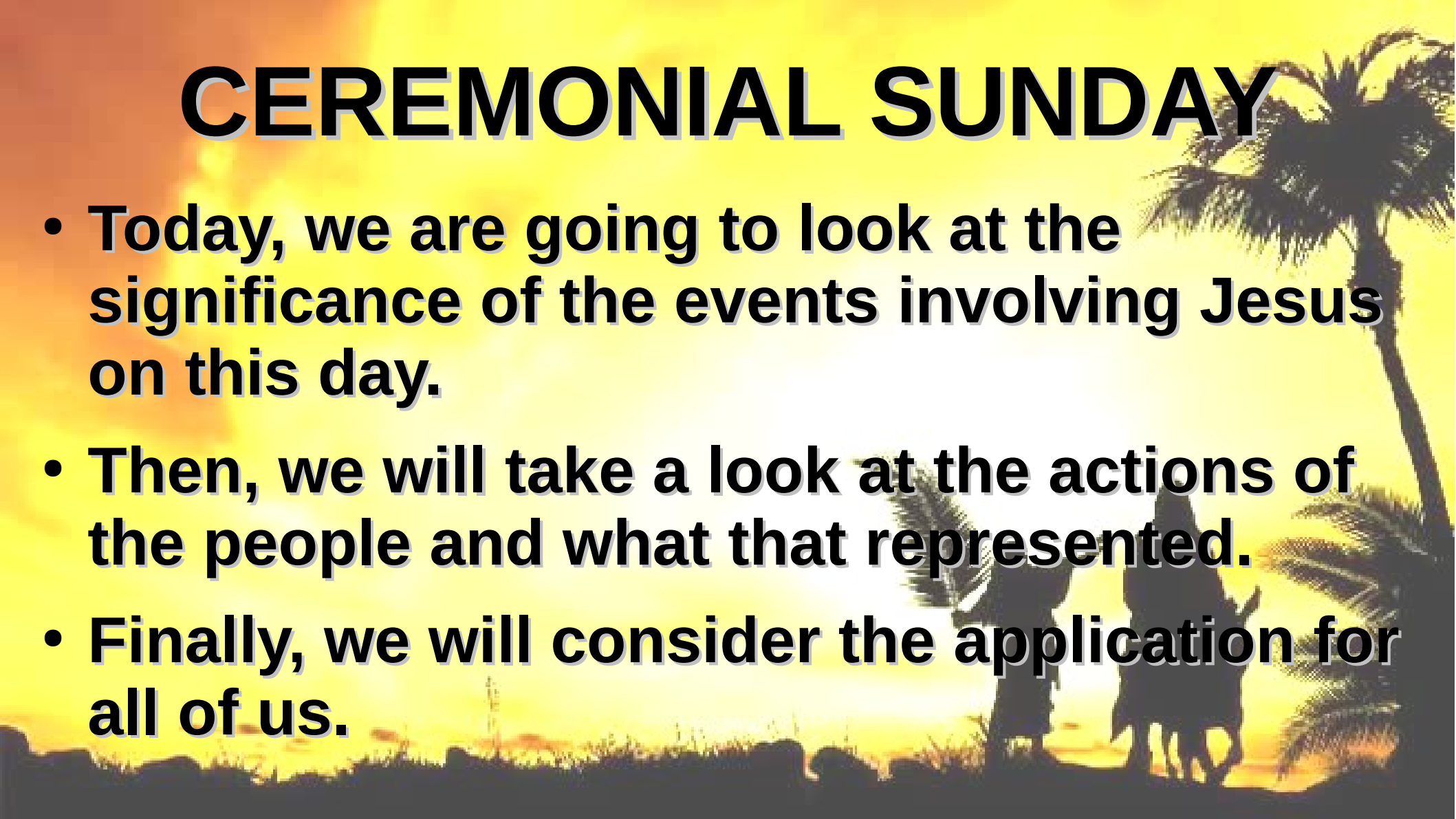


CEREMONIAL SUNDAY

- **The Sunday before Jesus's crucifixion is known by a variety of designations.**
 - **Some refer to it as Palm Sunday.**
 - **If you have description headings for the paragraph sections in your Bible then you probably know this Sunday as the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem.**

- **Finally, we will consider the application for all of us.**



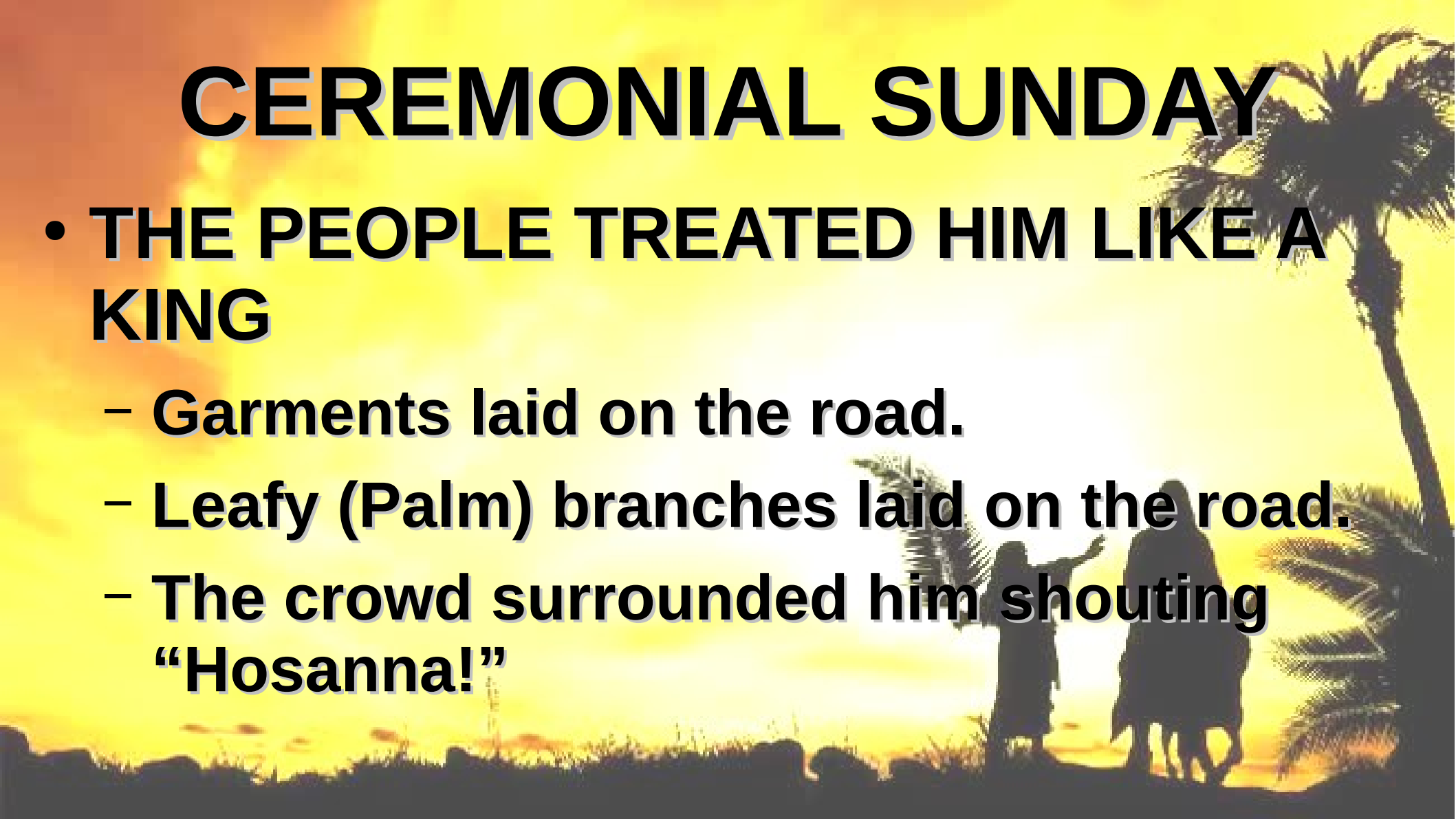
CEREMONIAL SUNDAY

 - **The colt, the foal of a donkey.**
 - **Never before ridden.**
 - **Taken with no payment.**

- **THE PEOPLE TREATED HIM LIKE A KING**
 - **Garments laid on the road.**
 - **Leafy (Palm) branches laid on the road.**
 - **The crowd surrounded him shouting “Hosanna!”**
