# MISREPRESENTATION MONDAY Some things are just not always what they appear

- Some things are just not always what they appear to be.

  - A movie.
- Maybe this has happened to you also.
  - Your expectations about an individual.
  - Your expectations about a congregation.

# MONDAY

- The Monday before Jesus's death was certainly such a day.
- Two major events are recorded that demonstrate why this was the case.
  - The cursing of the fig tree.
  - The cleansing of the Temple.
- Today, we are going to explore these two events.

#### THE FIG TREE

- After spending the night in Bethany, Jesus gets up early to go to Jerusalem.
  - He is very hungry.
  - Fig tree had green leaves but no fruit.
  - Jesus curses the tree.

- Jesus makes his way to the court of the Gentiles, where animals were purchased.
- No doubt disgusted by what he had already seen the night before, he has returned to set things straight.

- Jesus drove out those who sold and bought in the temple.
  - He overturned tables.
  - He refused to let anyone carry anything through the temple.

- What was so offensive that caused this reaction?
  - The same thing that caused irritation towards the fig tree.
  - Misrepresentation. A house of prayer had been turned into a den of robbers.

  - Merchandising
  - Money changing
  - Mockery
