- We sing the song, "Soldiers of Christ Arise."
- Notice the 3rd verse to this song.
 - "But take to arm you for the fight, the <u>panoply</u> of God."

Merriam Webster Dictionary defines a panoply as "a full suit of armor". A knight in panoply was completely arrayed and ready for battle.
 In a spiritual sense we think about Eph. 6:10-ff

- He makes reference to the fact that he has some divine power available to him to be able to defeat his opponents.
- This same power is available to us if we will tap into it.
