Hosea 6:4

- Over the last couple of decades, two products have benefited from this clever marketing campaign.
- First, Nike with "Just Do It" and
- Secondly, Mountain Dew with "Just Dew It."

- In the case of our text this morning, obviously, one trumps the other.
- It is apparent that God is tired of these covenant transgressors. Hosea 5:8-15
- It is even more frustrating to think about their expectations and reasoning. Hosea 6:1-3
- There insincerity is maddening. What they say is true but there is no real plan to follow through!!

- Listen to what God says about them in Hosea 6:4.
- They are like the hearts of those described as "rocky soil" in Luke 8:13.
- There are many examples of people like this.
- This morning we need to evaluate whether we are do-gooders or dew-gooders.

- The following are some dew-gooders:
  - Saul- I Sam. 10-12
  - Solomon- I Kings 11
  - **Demas- II Tim. 4:10**
  - Galatian Christians- Gal. 1:6
  - They started out fine but their faith fizzled.

- Do-gooders on the other hand endure.
- What is the key to this endurance?
- Following their conversion in Acts 2, it is said about these Christians that they "continued steadfastly."
- Reminds me of I Cor. 15:58.

- KEEP FAVOR WITH ALL THE PEOPLE!
