Luke 1:30

 - What must have been going through Joseph's mind, when he found out Mary was pregnant?
 - What must have been going through Mary's mind when she faced the prospect of having to tell Joseph?

- How about when your wife is in labor and there are no rooms available for the delivery?
- What about when the wise men were warned not to go back to Herod?
- Or, when Joseph was told to leave his home country and go to Egypt because Herod was going to seek the child to destroy him?

- So, there is surrounding this story.....
 - A man and a woman working through the issues of a marriage on the verge of divorce!
 - The navigating of the tricky political circumstances for the wise men and Joseph.
 - The stress associated with household relocation and job replacement.

- This holiday season, I have heard the song by the group Alabama entitled, "Angels Among Us" several times.
- I was reminded that in each of these situations there was an angel present to ease the fear and offer guidance.
- Heb. 1:14

- Matt. 1:20- "....do not fear."
- Luke 1:30- "....do not be afraid."
- Luke 2:10- "....fear not."
- All of this fear was met with faith.
