### **Romans 13:7**

- Our text teaches us to give "respect to whom respect is due and honor to whom honor is due."

- Gen 3- The serpent Satan, tempting Adam & Eve.
  - The snake/devil was guilty of misrepresenting God's word. Of course, we know he is a liar.
    - John 8:44
    - Rev. 12:9

- The wicked activities of men are linked to snakes:
  - Evil men having the "poison of vipers" on their lips- Ps. 140:3.
  - Of liars having "venom...like the venom of a snake- Ps. 58:4-5.

- The wicked activities of men are linked to snakes:
  - In regards to alcohol eventually "biting like an adder"- Prov. 23:32.
  - Hypocrisy (esp. of Pharisees) caused John the Baptist and Jesus to call them a "brood of vipers"-Matt. 3:7; 12:34; 23:33.
