Genesis 1:28

- These are the words given by God to Adam and Eve.
- Perhaps, we should call it the "Creation Mandate."
- My belief is that God intended them to reproduce godly offspring with which to fill this earth. Sadly, they didn't make it even to their first child before things went south.
- Certainly, by their first litter, sin had made its mark (pun intended) and by Gen. 6:5 it was real bad.

- These words are again spoken in Gen. 9:7 to Noah and his family.
- I suppose we will call this the "Post-Diluvian Mandate."
- As with the first occasion in Gen. 1:28, my assumption is that God also intended for Noah's family to reproduce godly seed and fill the earth.
- But, considering our current environment that trend doesn't seem to have become popular either.

- There is a similar directive given in the New Test.
- Matt. 28:19-20, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you....."
- This could be called the "Post-Resurrection Mandate."
- Probably better known as the "Great Commission."

- Do we really appreciate the fact that we are commanded to be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth?
  - What Jesus has in mind folks, as made apparent in Matt. 28, is that we multiply godliness on this earth. That spiritual offspring be reproduced.
  - Matt. 5:14-16

- I have had a change of heart about a few things recently.

- It scares me quite a bit to think about the world they will grow up in.
- But, I have adjusted my thinking on this for two reasons:

  - I had a car accident and what transpired broke my heart.

  - II Peter 1:3-8
- START WORKING FOR OTHERS!!!!
  - Be concerned about others- Rom. 10:1; Tit. 3:14
- START WORKING WITH CHRIST!!!!
  - John 15:1-8
