#### **Matthew 4:1-11**

 There are several verses in the Bible that specifically urge us to practice selfcontrol.

- Galatians 5:23
- II Peter 1:6
- Titus 1:6 (of bishops) & 2:2 (of aged men)

 If you are looking for the word self-control in the KJV, then you will see the word temperance or temperate used instead.

• The meaning of the root word in Greek is, "be strong in something (masterful)."

• The KJV version of I Cor. 9:25 illustrates this well. "And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things."

 Although, the word self-control (temperance) only appears a few times in the scriptures, other manifestations of self-control litter the pages of the Bible, such as: self-denial, sacrifice, and unselfishness.

- Ex. like Joseph, Moses, and John the Baptist.

 But, there is no greater example than Jesus, which leads us back to our text in Matthew 4.

- Jesus exercised self-control in the face of temptation.
  - Mastered the "lust of the flesh."
  - Mastered the "pride of life."
  - Mastered the "lust of the eyes."
- How was he able to do it?
   WILL POWER!!!!!!

 If we want to practice self-control like Jesus then we are going to have to develop will power.

And what I mean by that is.....
 Will (OF GOD) Power!!!!!!!

 Jesus' motivation for everything that he did was the will of God- Look at John 4:34.

Peter echoes this for us in I Peter 4:2 when he says..

- Brothers and sisters, we can't do this on our own. We need God's will to influence and motivate us.
- We need to ask, "what is God's will in every situation we encounter in life?"
- And in order to fulfill that will, we need to understand it and be committed to it. Then you will have developed self-control like Jesus.

- So what does this look like?
  - When you are tempted to look at that inappropriate image on your computer, think about the will of God!
  - When you are tempted to wear an outfit that does not profess godliness, think about the will of God!
    When you are tempted to indulge in sinful, selfish behaviors, think about the will of God!
