 - Philistines have captured the ark of the covenant following their victory over Israel, that lead to the death of Eli and his two sons.
 - They take the ark as a spoil of war and place it in the temple of Dagon in Ashdod.
 - Some strange things begin to happen while the ark is there.

- Telling the story:
 - The men of the land are struck with tumors and a plague of mice terribly affects the area.
 - The Ark was moved from town to town in the land of the Philistines; but, the people were in a deadly panic and so sought to return the Ark to the land of Israel

- They saw that their god Dagon was...... when in the presence of the God of Israel.

 - I Sam. 5:3
- Destroyed/Injured
 - I Sam. 5:4
- Deficient/Inferior- I Sam. 5:7; 6:5

- They the God of Israel
- Recognized- I Sam. 5:7
- Responded to "What shall we do?"
- Returned the ark with a gift.- I Sam. 6:3-4, They sent a guilt offering.
- Respected- "Gave glory to the God of Israel."- I Sam. 6:5

- Yet, they still opted to worship Dagon.
