

Genesis 11.1-9

- V 1 The whole earth had on language
- V 3 The came up with new technology
- Key Verse
 - The people said to each other, "Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be dispersed over the face of the whole earth" (11:4).

They Had Two Concerns

- Concern 1
 - They want to make a name for themselves
 - Why is this an issue? (Genesis 1.26-27)
 - Our purpose is to bear the image of God...
 - They wanted to make a name for themselves
 - This is a problem with pride

The Had Two Concerns

- Concern 2
 - They do not want to be dispersed over the earth
 - Why is this an issue? (Genesis 1.28)
 - Humans are to spread out over the earth, acting as God's representatives in every place
 - In their pride they think they can live how they want to live and do what they want to do.

The Lord Speaks

- These people think they can do whatever they want and live how they want.
- The Lord speaks in v.6-7
- What is God's concern?
- That they will gather together and only do evil
- So what does God do?

Pride Loves Praise

- Pride wants the praise of people
- This is a warning flag for our hearts
- Social media plays a big role in it! Post for praise?
- Are we wanting us to be glorified or God? Matthew
 5.16
- Attention goes to God. Honor goes to God. Glory goes to God. Humility wants God to be praised

Pride Loves Security

- We think we can make our lives secure
- The tower is for praise of people, city Is so they are not disturbed
- I will get an education. I will get a job. I will make a lot of money. I will build a house. I will have a family. I will enjoy life. I will store up my wealth. I will retire. I will take my rest.

Pride Loves Security

- Luke 12.16-21
- Pride thinks that we can insulate ourselves from trouble.
- God has shown us that all our experience, wisdom, wealth, education, and planning are nothing to him.
- Only God can make our lives safe and secure. We find our security only in the Lord, not in ourselves

God Knows

- God knows our heart, we can't hide pride from him
- We think we build such great things and have such great accomplishments. But the Lord has to come down to see it.
- James 4.6- God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble

Conclusion

- We find grace when we lose our pride problem
- Pride stands against God because the world becomes about us rather than God
- Humility wants God to be praised
