- In the final lesson from our series on Titus, our focus will be on God's redemptive work.
- The first thing that needs to be emphasized, is that our salvation is not because of works done by us in righteousness.
- Paul is quick to point this out.
- His motive for this is most likely the false teachers he is referencing in verse 9. Let's look.

### CONTINUES IN THE RENEWAL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- This is a reference to the work that the Holy Spirit is continually doing in us to....
  - Mortify sin- Col. 3:5
  - Produce the fruits of righteousness- Gal. 5:22

- Paul is going to discuss in chapter three being devoted to good works.
  - Why is this so important?
    - Because it verifies what James was saying in James 2:18. Good works validates our faith.
    - It shows that the work of God has made a difference in our lives. Not because of our own righteousness or so we can boast (Eph. 2:9) but to glorify God and his work.
