- We would like to think that this is just a societal redefining of sin; but sadly, it is happening in the religious world.

THAT SECULAR EDUCATION TRUMPS BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE

- Bible class is optional but ACT prep is not.
- We have students that can make a 30 on the ACT but can't cite 5 verses to teach about salvation.
- I'm not just singling out the young people.
- Ecclesiastes warns us about this- 1:17-18; 12:13.
